Opportunity to look at CBT and self-help approaches to managing mental health. Lee will dispel the myth that therapy is a passive process in which a therapist speaks to you and 'makes you feel better'. Rather therapy is a process by which the therapist works to develop the tools and resilience in individuals to help themselves manage and maintain their own mental health. Lee will give participants tools to go away and work on whatever they may be struggling with or may struggle with in the future, without having to enter into a therapeutic relationship with them.

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Course Content: Michael will facilitate a discussion where teachers are given the opportunity to air their concerns and share any thoughts on the teaching of maths in Reception, Year 1 or Year 2. Using screen share on Zoom, Michael is able to discuss curriculum coverage as it stood at the start of lockdown, and identify those strands of Maths that have not been delivered. Using a year group transition document Michael will be able to analyse the lessons in the forthcoming year in strands and consider the extent to which they addressed prior year group learning that had not taken place. Some of the lessons from the previous year would be used as a starting point before embarking on the relevant series of lessons for the next year. Michael has discovered that this has led him to slim down the curriculum for the coming year. Through Zoom this can be shared for you to consider your maths curriculum for the forthcoming year in EYFS and KS1.
