Getting ready for the Revised EYFS - Communication and Language. 1.5 hours.
Date: **Monday 19th April 3.00pm to 4.30pm** Communication and Language are at the core of the revised EYFS and have become the golden thread throughout. You will become more familiar with the revised aspects of Communication and Language and develop your understanding of how to support children's language learning. **£15.00**

Getting Ready for the Revised EYFS - Physical Development; 1.5 hours.
Date: **Wednesday 21st April 3.00pm to 4.30pm**. This short session will look at the important features for children's physical development in the *revised* Early Years Foundation Stage. We will explore the inclusion of fine and gross motor development for children. We will carefully consider how to plan for children's progress and how to provide irresistible physical learning environments for young children. **£15.00**

Getting Ready for the Revised EYFS - Personal, Social and Emotional Development. 1.5 hours.

Date: **Wednesday 28th April 3.00 to 4.30pm**. In this session, we will explore how children become independent, build relationships as well as looking at the new terminology around self-regulation. We will look into how children become confident learners and critical thinkers. You will develop your understanding of why developing children's self-regulation is of great significance to their overall learning. **£15.00**

'MOVERS' is the Movement Environment Rating Scales. This evidence-based, high quality instrument measures the quality of the physical environment and adult interactions when supporting young children to develop their physical skills.

Gain a deeper understanding of how the brain and body are linked inextricably

- Understanding how to use movement language with children
- Providing irresistible physical learning environments for young children
- Use research to improve teacher and practitioner knowledge of physical development
- Knowing the importance and benefits of early movement, nutrition and sleep

- Linking MOVERS to other areas of childhood development
- Improving practice through self-evaluation
