

SLE Mathematics - Michael Sheerin – Assistant Headteacher

Planning a recovery curriculum that reduces the impact of partial school closures in progress pupil in Maths (although as a model it's transferable to other areas of the curriculum).

Michael will facilitate a discussion where teachers are given the opportunity to air their concerns and share any thoughts on the **teaching of maths in Reception or Year 1 or Year 2.**

Using screen share on zoom Michael is able to discuss curriculum coverage as it stood at the start of lockdown, and identify those strands of Maths that have not been delivered. Using a year group transition document Michael will be able to analyse the lessons in the forthcoming year in those strands, and consider the extent to which they addressed prior year group learning that had not taken place. Because Maths No Problem is based on a spiral curriculum, in some cases those lessons sufficed. Some of the lessons from the previous year groups would be used as a starting point before embarking on the relevant series of lessons from the next year. Michael has discovered that this has led him to consider slimming down the curriculum for the coming year- he has started to identify those lessons which may be dropped.

During these Zoom meetings, Michael will consider the needs of individual children in each class. Using a transition document that outlines key objectives from both year groups, teachers will be able to identify those children that may need support in specific areas.
